The Mediterranean's largest island and one of its main wine regions. The red wine Nero d'Avola and the white wines Inzolia, Grillo and Catarrato are among the island's most iconic wines. Sicily produces a lot of large volume wines but is also home to a number of boutique wine makers whose approach is far from mainstream.

CVA - VITICULTORI ASSOCIATI CANICATTI

Around the town of Agrigento over 480 farmers created CVA Canicatti in 1969, one of Southern Italy's most awarded co-operative. It specialises in making wines using local grapes. Make no mistake, while this is a co-operative the attention to detail is central to what they do ensuring excellent wines at the right price. The flag-bearer is Diodoros, a red blend of ancient grape varieties discovered in a vineyard below the Temple of Juno.
