Umbria's climate and land are similar to those of the neighbouring Tuscany, having cold winters and hot summers. Sangiovese and Trebbiano grapes are the most popular having been introduced by the Benedictine monks. It is Umbria's reds that are attracting worldwide attention and with good reason. It is a good area for any price sensitive Italian enthusiast to explore.

## LUNGAROTTI

Lungarotti is possibly Umbria's most prestigious winery, established in 1962 by Giorgio Lungarotti. They have been at the forefront of gaining recognition for Umbria as a wine-producing region.

Their trademark is Rubesco Riserva "Vigna Monticchio", a Single Vineyard using only 100% Sangiovese grapes and considered one of Italy's best red wines.
